

## LCCI English for Business Speaking Test Topics

The Speaking Test is a Test of English with a commercial and/or business focus. The topics are the same for all Levels (B1, B2 and C1). The depth at which the Topics will be treated depends on the relevant CEF level. There are 8 Topics from which specific questions will be prepared by LCCI as the context for the Test:

<b>Earning a Living</b>	wages, living standards job types and roles candidate's (intended) job employee/employer relationships organizational type/structure
<b>Production, Sale of Goods and Services</b>	distribution: origin and destination of products retail and wholesale/small shops/supermarkets new markets and products consumer protection customer service/quality
<b>Trade</b>	imports/exports international markets trade blocs e.g. EU issues in developing countries
<b>Money</b>	methods of paying, purchasing price changes, inflation banking services savings and investment pensions
<b>Transport</b>	logistics and transportation types individual, commercial, industrial local, national, international advantages and disadvantages improvements congestion pollution
<b>Communications</b>	effects on business effects on individuals media: TV, radio, newspapers, Internet Social networking IT, computers, PCs telephone, email, fax, surface mail advertising
<b>Education</b>	personal education system training skills
<b>Travel and Tourism</b>	travel and the individual tourism and local area tourism in the nation's economy
